Heal the Streets

1. Identifying and training the second cohort (10-12 youth) of *Heal the Streets* fellows in violence prevention advocacy.
2. Holding a formal presentation of youth's violence prevention strategies and recommendations to Oakland Unified School District and Oakland City Council in June 2011.
3. Engaging 500+ community members in youth-led community strategy sessions, focus groups, community surveys/research, and various community events.

Books Not Bars

1. Family participation in political education and skill building trainings and community events
2. Level of family engagement in advocacy and their participation in helping draft legislation; and
3. Growth of family membership, involvement and support for Books Not Bars in Alameda County through organizing.


